**Number of participants:** Limited to 4

**Schedule:** A commitment is required for a consecutive 4-month period in order to build safety and trust with one another and consistency for the group as a whole.

**Dates:** The dates and times for each monthly meeting will be decided upon by the group's individual schedules and Pat's. Day times, weekends, and some evenings are possible. All dates, including a back-up date for emergencies & inclement weather, are set a month in advance.

**Place:** Pat's Studio in Natick.

**Fee:** \$75.00 per person, per 3-hour session.
